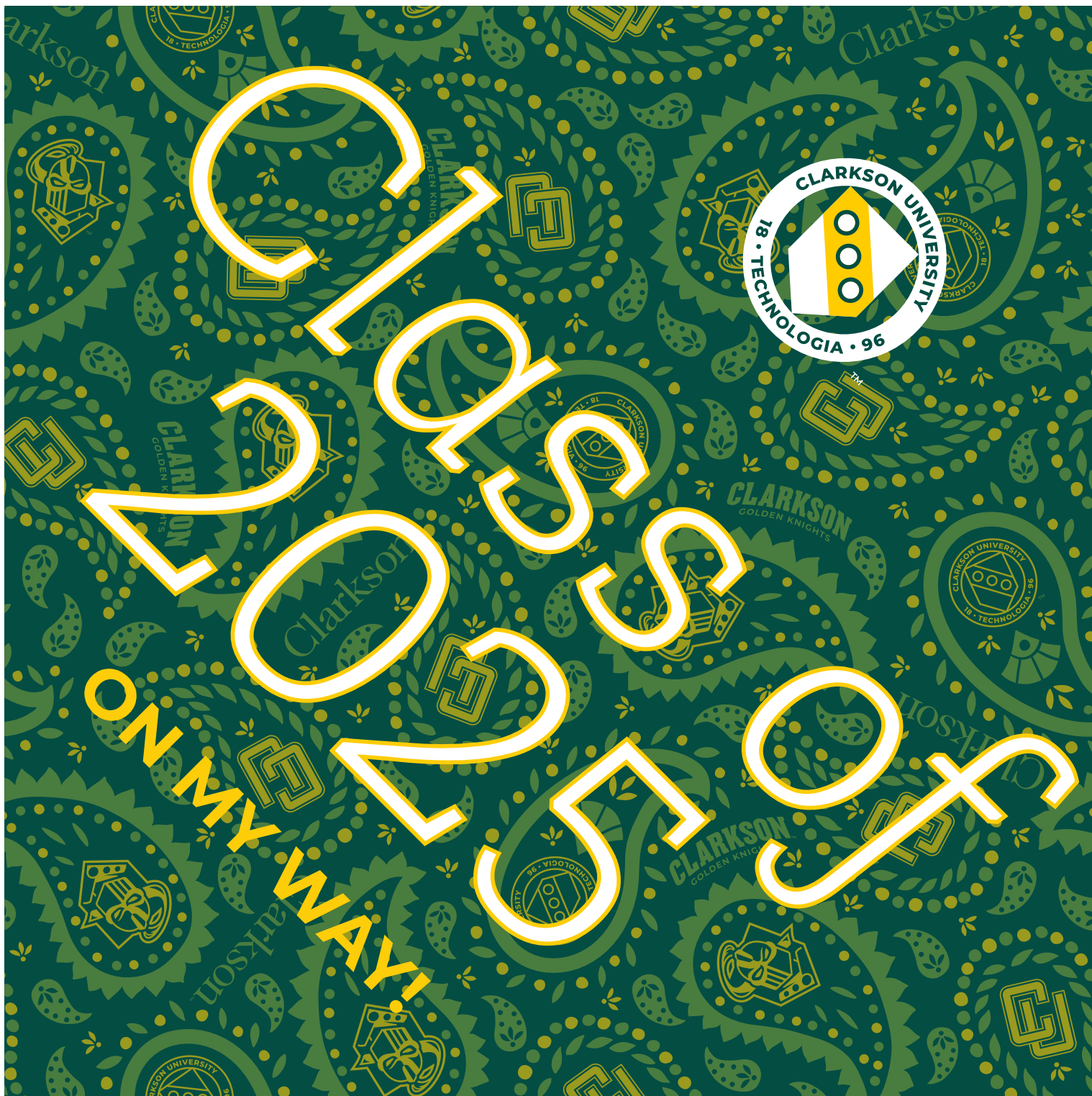




Tassel Topper

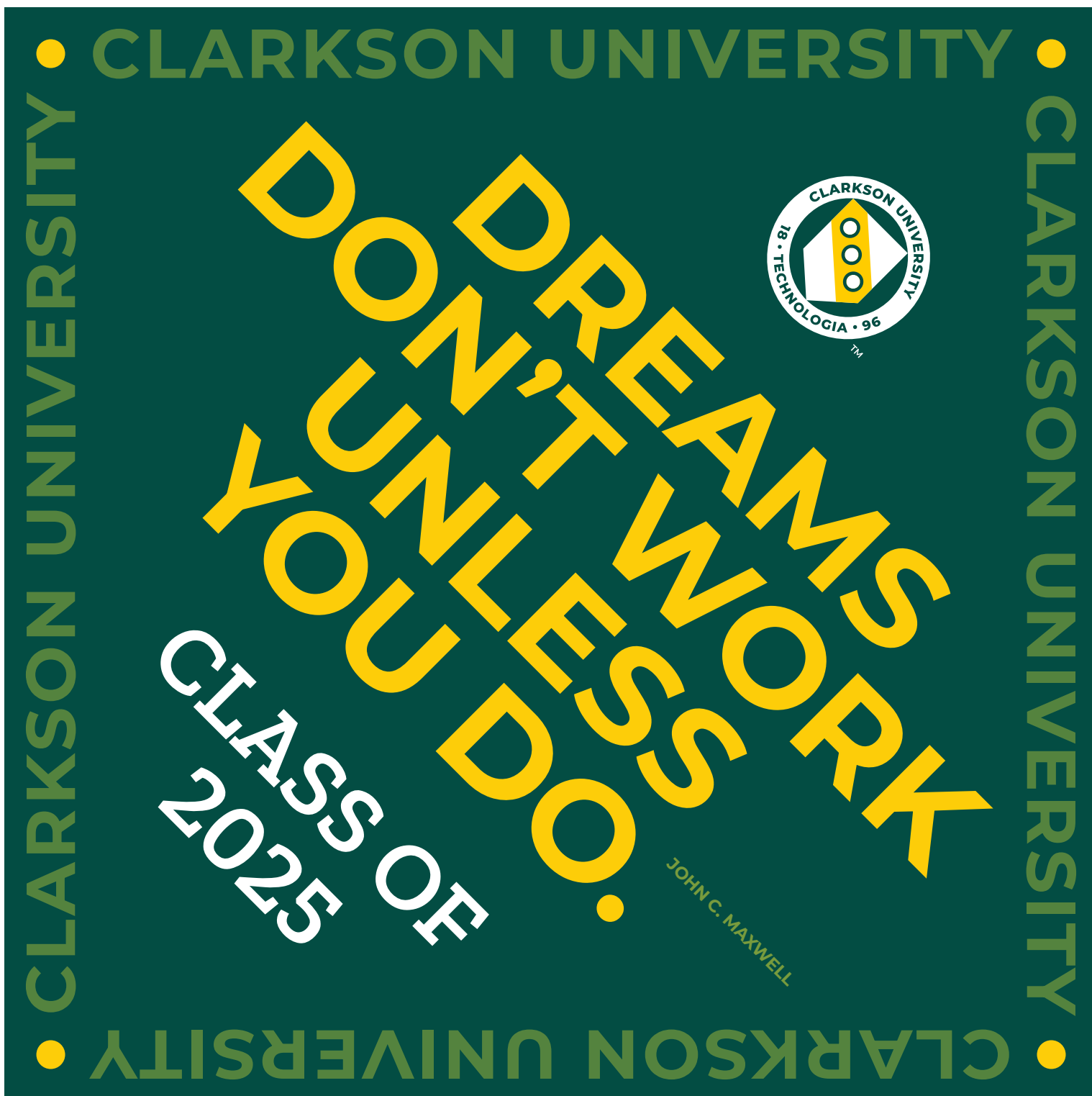
